# Location

The property is situated on the south side of West Hill (A3) to the west of its junction with Merton Road. Local amenities are available along West Hill itself and the further facilities of both Wandsworth and Putney are accessible. Nearest Underground services run from East Putney Station (District Line) and Wandsworth Town Rail Station is to the east. The open spaces of both Wandsworth Park and King George's Park are within reach. Both the A3 and A205 (South Circular Road) are accessible. The River Thames is to the north.

## Description

The property comprises a Grade II Listed mid terrace building arranged over lower ground, ground, first and second floors beneath a tile clad roof. The building is internally arranged to provide three selfcontained flats. Each flat benefits from its own entrance. Flat 23B is approached from West Hill whilst Flats 23A and 23C are accessed from the rear via Wandle Mews, which runs off the west side of Merton Road. There are two car parking spaces to the rear.
