Tenure

Leasehold. The property is to be held on a new lease for a term of 125 years from the date of completion at an initial ground rent of $\pounds155$ per annum (rising).

Location

The property is situated on the north side of Warwick Avenue, not far from its junction with Sutherland Avenue. Little Venice, home to a number of waterside cafés, pubs and eateries, is close by. A more extensive range of shops and amenities is available within the West End to the south-east. Access to the London Underground network is provided by Warwick Avenue Station (Bakerloo Line), which is within a 5-minute walk to the south-east. The property is well served by several bus routes heading into the centre of London, whilst Edgware Road (A5) provides access to the M1 and in turn the M25 Motorways. Paddington Recreation Ground is within a 10-minute walk to the north.
