Location

The property is situated on the north side of Fernside Road, to the east of its junction with Mayford Road, in a well established and popular residential area known locally as 'The Nightingale Triangle'. Local amenities are available along Bellevue Road, with the further facilities of both Balham High Road and Northcote Road also being accessible. Rail services run from both Wandsworth Common and Balham Stations and Underground services run from Balham Station (Northern Line). The open spaces of Wandsworth Common are within easy reach. The A3 is to the north and the North Circular Road (A205) is to the east. A number of schools are close by including Noah's Ark Nursery School, The Montessori School and Chestnut Grove Academy.
