Share of Freehold/Long Leasehold. The property is held on a lease for a term of 999 years from 1st January 2015 (thus having approximately 998 years unexpired) at a ground rent of £300 per annum.

Location

The property is located on the east side of Engel Park, to the south of its junction with Bittacy Hill (B552). Local shops and restaurants together with well-regarded independent schooling are within reach. Rail services to Central London, as well as both Gatwick and Luton International Airports, run from Mill Hill Broadway Station and Northern Line Underground services are also available from Mill Hill East Station. The B552 provides access to the Great North Way and in turn the North Circular Road (A406), A1 and M1 Motorway. The Arrandene Open Space and Bittacy Hill Park are within easy reach. Mill Hill Golf Club, Finchley Golf Club and the Mill Hill Country Club are also close by.
