

Location

Leyton is a densely populated suburb of North East London located approximately 6 miles north-east of the City. The local area is in close proximity to Stratford which has seen significant infrastructure investment over the last decade, including the Westfield Shopping Centre and Olympic Stadium.

The property is located within part of the grounds of Langthorne Hospital, off High Road Leytonstone (A11), and less than 0.5 miles from Leyton Underground Station (Central Line)

The property is situated in a popular mixed commercial and residential area.

Description

This attractive Grade II listed property is arranged on ground and two upper floors to provide treatment rooms with accompanying staff and office accommodation.

The property forms part of a larger gated estate, which comprises three other buildings all operated by the NHS treating mental health.

The entire property is at present let to NORTH EAST LONDON NHS FOUNDATION TRUST for a term of 25 years from 27th June 2000 at a current rent of £28,000 per annum. The lease provides for rent reviews every third year of the term and contains full repairing and insuring covenants.

There is a rolling tenant break option at, or any time after, the end of the 15th year.
