Location

The property is situated on the west side of King's Cross Road to the south of its junction with Frederick Street and within walking distance of both King's Cross and St Pancras Stations and Exmouth Market where an extensive range of public houses, bars and restaurants can be found. The Brunswick Centre and the leisure facilities of the West End are also readily accessible. London Underground Stations and both National and International Rail services run from King's Cross and St Pancras Stations, whilst numerous bus routes also serve the area.

Description

The property comprises a unique mid terrace house arranged over basement, ground and three upper floors. The building was formerly used for Arts exhibition events before being converted to residential use in 2011 and benefits from high ceilings and plenty of natural light. There is a roof terrace which offers panoramic views over Finsbury. The property further benefits from access to the nearby Frederick Street Garden.
