

Location

The property is located to the east side of the A4111 and opposite its junction with Park Road. The A4111 provides access to the A438 located to the south and provides direct access to Hereford city centre, where an extensive range of shops and other facilities are available. National Rail services run from Hereford Station located approximately 16 miles to the south-east. The open spaces of Brecon Beacons National Park are located nearby.
